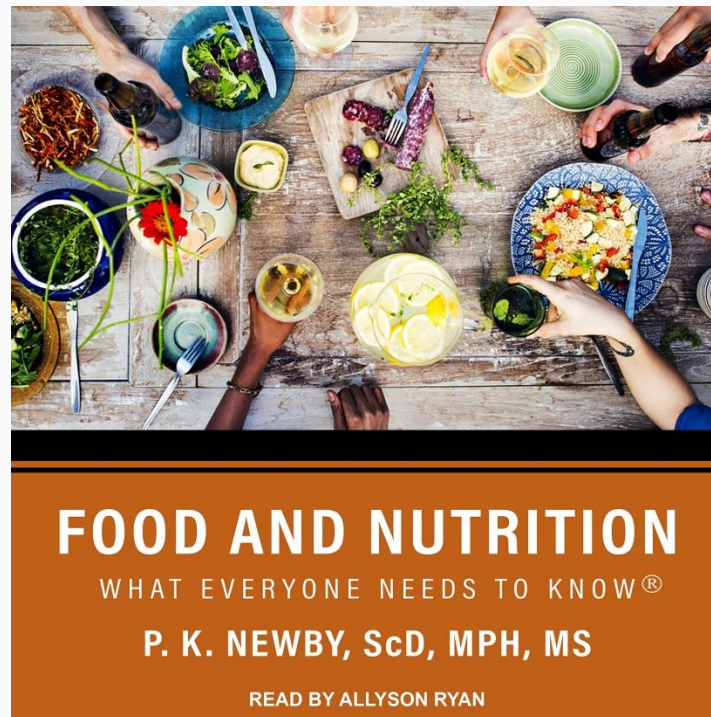

All resources in Quebec now available in one online directory

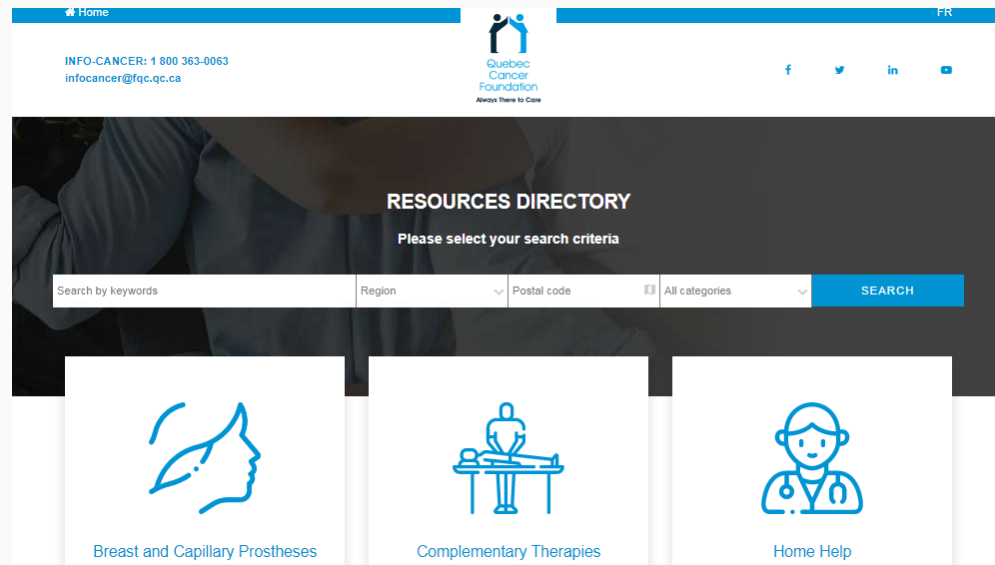
